Today: John 1:4-5 The Word: The Light, to man, shining victoriously in the darkness

* The physical darkness we understand, and the need for physical light in order to live we also understand

* The truth about the spiritual darkness of the soul (& thus the life) the natural man does not grasp, as well as the One, True source of Light

* Of the seven 'I am' statements of Jesus in John's gospel account only this one, He as the Light of the world, is applied directly to us as His people. He is the true Light but we are as those who are 'salt and light' before the world (Mt.5:14-16).
